2021-22 Broomstones ADULT Member COVID-19 Policies Attestation

As a member of Broomstones Curling Club, I will follow the club policies outlined in this updated attestation form during the 2021-22 season.

Members

- I will wear a properly fitted facemask when off the ice (I will either broomstack outside or if inside I will lift mask briefly to allow sip/bite and then replace it).
- I will socially distance when possible, including on the ice and avoid crowding in warm areas.
- I will come dressed to play, if possible, and limit my time in the locker rooms.
- If I am a *vaccine-eligible Broomstones member*, I must be *fully vaccinated* to enter the building, meaning I have received the 2nd dose of either the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines or a single dose of the J&J vaccine more than 14 days ago.
- I will provide proof of full vaccination as part of the registration process for all curling activities (e.g., leagues, events, rentals).

Booster Shots are strongly recommended:

- If I previously received the J&J vaccine and I am aged 16 and older, I will get a booster shot 2 months after my initial vaccine.
- If I previously received either the Moderna or Pfizer vaccines and am aged 16 and older, I will get the appropriate booster shot 6 months (Moderna) or 5 months (Pfizer) after my second dose in the initial series of shots.

Note: Having the booster shot is the best defense against this new variant of COVID-19.

Once 80% of our adult members have received a booster shot, we will be better protected and can consider relaxing the mask mandate.

- If I am an unvaccinated member who is age-eligible to be vaccinated, but not medically eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine, I will submit a written request for a medical exemption with a signed note from a qualified healthcare provider to medical@broomstones.com for review and approval.
 - I will not participate in any club activities, including events, nor enter the building until my exemption is approved by a qualified [medical@broomstones](mailto:medical@broomstones.com) reviewer.
 - As an unvaccinated member, after I am approved and regardless of the policy for fully vaccinated members, I will wear a mask at all times while in the club and/or curling.

Guests of Members

- I am responsible for my guests following the procedures outlined in this document as well as all other club rules.
- Any guest(s) over the age of 5 invited to the club must be fully vaccinated and must:
 - provide proof of vaccination status; AND
 - upon arrival sign the non-member attestation form and provide contact info (for close-contact informing).

- If I bring a guest to the club who is not vaccine eligible due to age < 5 years, I will be responsible for their always wearing a mask. Children under 2 years of age are not required to wear a mask.
- If my guest(s) inform(s) me that they became sick while at Broomstones and/or received a positive test result within 48 hours of having been at the club, I will immediately inform the applicable Event or League Coordinator AND medical@broomstones.com.

Feeling Unwell

- I agree NOT to enter the club if:
 - o I am sick or not feeling well, especially if I have any symptoms such as: cough, fatigue, sore throat, congestion/runny nose, headache, fever or chills, muscle/body aches, new loss of taste/smell, shortness of breath/difficulty breathing, nausea, vomiting or diarrhea.
 - o I have a fever (>100.4°F) or felt feverish in the past 72 hours
- If I become ill while at Broomstones, I will immediately:
 - o ensure my face mask is properly in place
 - o maintain at least 6 feet (2 m) of distance from others
 - o inform the league, event, or rental coordinator (or Broomstones representative)
 - o after notifying the coordinator, promptly leave the premises
 - o email medical@broomstones.com
- In either case, Broomstones strongly recommends the unwell member to be tested for COVID-19 and if positive not return to Broomstones until day 6 after the test and provided I am symptom-free for two days.

COVID-19 Close Contact, Symptomatic/Testing Positive:

- I agree to follow, at a minimum, current CDC and MA Health Department guidance as well as local and state regulations regarding quarantine and isolation for COVID-19 exposure and illness.
- There is a 10-day observation period after exposure to or testing positive for COVID-19 for which there are stricter rules to follow.
- I agree to notify via email medical@broomstones.com the results of my COVID-19 testing.

Close Contact

- COVID-19 Close Contact definition: Anyone who was within 6 feet of an infected person for a total of ≥15 minutes over a 24-hour period.
- I agree that if I have been exposed to COVID-19 or am notified I am a COVID-19 close contact, I should get a **PCR test administered by a healthcare worker approximately 5 days after the date I was exposed**. A Rapid Test (Antigen test) is not acceptable as it is not sensitive enough, especially for the omicron variant.

During the 10-day observation period:

- If I have **recently received a booster shot** or are within 6 months of receiving my second Moderna or within 5 months of receiving my second Pfizer shot or 2 months of receiving the J&J vaccine, then I may continue to enter Broomstones and curl as long as I remain symptom-free

and wear a mask all the time. If my PCR test performed approximately 5 days after exposure is positive, I will isolate for at least 5 days and follow the protocol for having COVID.

- If I have **not received a booster shot** and completed my second Moderna shot more than 6 months ago, my second Pfizer shot more than 5 months ago or the J&J vaccine more than 2 months ago, I agree that during the 10-day observation period:
 - I will not return to Broomstones for at least 5 days
 - If during the initial 5-day observation period I was symptom-free, I may enter Broomstones and curl starting on day 6 as long as I continue to be symptom-free and I wear a mask all the time from day 6-10 inclusive. If my PCR test performed approximately 5 days after exposure is positive, I will isolate for at least 5 days and follow the protocol for having COVID.
- For the 10-day observation period after exposure regardless of booster status, I agree not to broomstack nor socialize in the warm areas, as these activities are not permitted for individuals who have been exposed to COVID-19 and may have the virus.

Symptomatic

If at any point I become symptomatic during the 10 days after my exposure or I develop symptoms consistent with COVID-19 without known exposure, I agree that:

- I will not enter Broomstones
- I will get a PCR test immediately
- I will not enter the Club until I have received a confirmed negative result.

Positive COVID-19 Test

If I test positive due regardless of the situation that led to exposure, I agree that:

- I will isolate myself for 5 days. I will only return to the club if I test negative on a rapid antigen test towards the end of the 5-day isolation period and I have been symptom-free for the 48 hours beforehand.
- If I test positive on the Day 5 rapid antigen test, I will continue to isolate for another 5 days.
- After returning to Broomstones, I will wear a mask at Broomstones and abstain from broomstacking and socializing for 5 additional days.
- If I test positive for COVID-19 or become ill with COVID-19-like symptoms within 48 hours of having been on the premises, I agree to report to the League or Event Coordinator AND email medical@Broomstones.com immediately to allow for contact informing.

At all times while entering, or bringing juniors or guests into Broomstones Curling Club, I agree to follow the Broomstones COVID-19 Policies. I acknowledge and agree that:

- Broomstones COVID-19 Policies may be stricter than any local, state, CDC, or federal health regulations, rules, laws, and guidance
- Broomstones COVID-19 Policies may change at any time due to the situation and status of knowledge and science
- I will keep myself fully apprised of the current Broomstones COVID-19 Policies so that I can remain in compliance.
